

CONSTELLATIONS WITH PHOSPHORESCENT STARS



What you need

- Black cardboard
- Scissors
- Adhesive phosphorescent stars
- Ruler and golden marker
- Awl
- Sky map software (such as Stellarium, Celestia, Starry Night, etc.)

How to build it

Print on a sheet the constellation chosen in a sky map software (such as Stellarium, Celestia, Starry Night, etc.). In Fig. 1 we give the example in the photography.

Place the sheet on a black cardboard (best placed over a cork surface, to protect the table) and, with an awl, pierce the stars into the sheet, crossing also the cardboard. Remove the sheet and stick a phosphorescent star on each of the holes made in the black cardboard. Join the stars with straight strokes of golden marker, aided by the ruler, thus reproducing the constellation drawing.

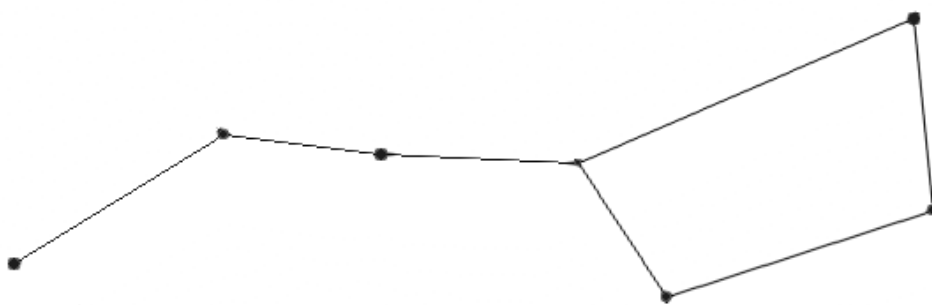
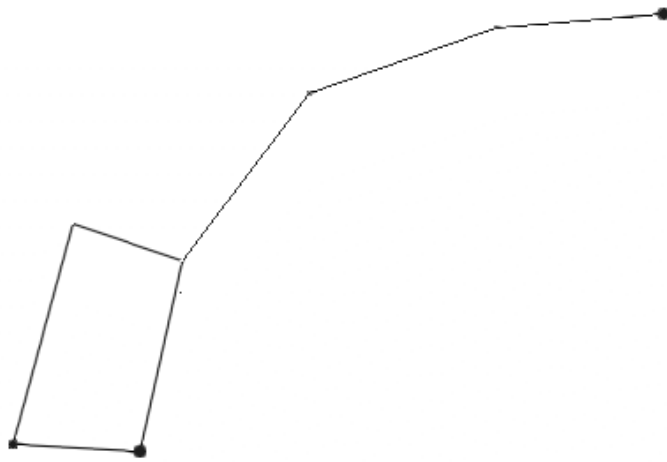
